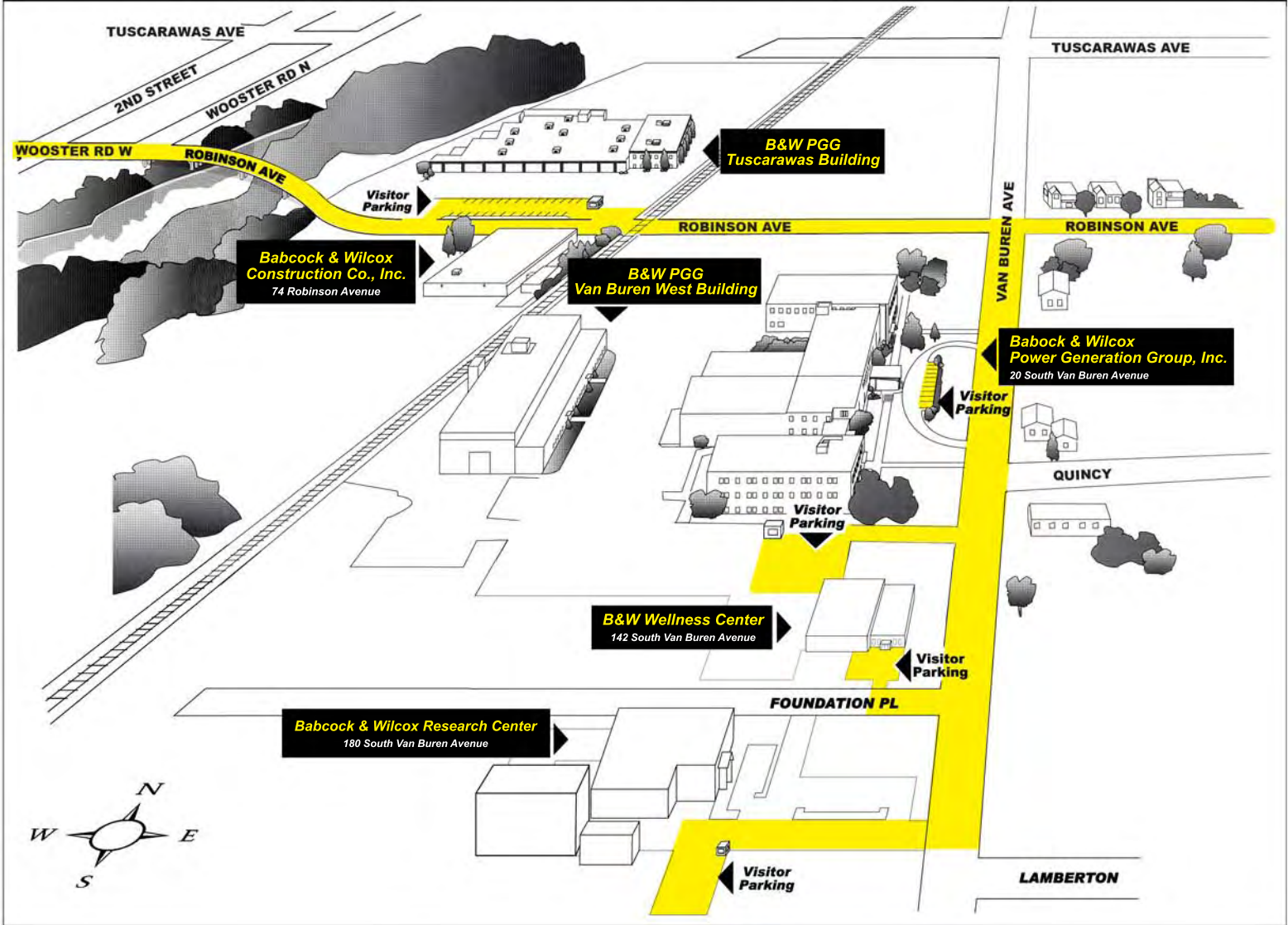

FROM CLEVELAND-HOPKINS AIRPORT TO B&W PGG

Allow one hour driving time.

- Exit the airport onto **Route 237 South** to **Snow Road East**.
- Take Snow Road east to **I-71 South** (Columbus) for approximately 17 miles.
- Exit onto **Route 18 East** (Akron).
- Take **I-77/Route 21 South**.
- Follow **Route 21 South** (Massillon) to **Route 585** (Barberton), and you will enter Barberton on **Wooster Road**.
- Follow **Wooster Road** through Barberton to the **Robinson Avenue** Bridge.
- Cross the bridge and the railroad track and turn right onto **Van Buren Avenue**.
- B&W PGG will be on your right (red brick building). Pass the main entrance of B&W and turn right into the main Visitor Parking Area at the south end of the building.

FROM AKRON-CANTON AIRPORT TO B&W PGG

Allow 30 minutes' driving time.

- Exit the airport onto **I-77 North** (Akron).
- Take **I-277 North/Route 224 West** (Barberton).
- Exit at **Manchester Road**, turning left at the bottom of the ramp.
- Follow Manchester Road south to **Robinson Avenue**; turn right.
- Take Robinson Avenue to **Van Buren Avenue**.
- Turn left onto Van Buren Avenue.
- B&W PGG will be on your right (red brick building). Pass the main entrance of B&W and turn right into the main Visitor Parking Area at the south end of the building.

FROM BARBERTON CAMPUS TO THE COPLEY BUILDING

Allow 20 minutes' driving time.

- Take **Wooster Road West** through Barberton to **Route 21 North**.
- Take **21 North** (from Akron or Barberton).
- Exit at **Copley Road** and turn right (east).
- Heading east and crossing over Cleveland-Massillon Road, continue around traffic circle. Facility will be on left (north) side of road, about one-half mile past circle.
