

# ITT Grinnell Constant Support Hangers

## **Purpose**

Advise owners and operators of a possible problem with ITT Grinnell constant support spring hangers.

#### **Problem**

Corrosion has been observed at the lever link and lever link connections on constant support hangers purchased from ITT Grinnell after 1964. The hangers involved are Figure Number 80V, Catalog Numbers PH-69 through PH-83 sizes 64 through 83 and Figure Number 80V, Catalog Number PH-65 sizes 42 through 54.

## Recommendations


Inspection and maintenance procedures should be reviewed to include the following:

#### Inspection

- Visually inspect the lever link at the top and bottom pivot points for signs of corrosion or flyash deposits.
- Visually inspect the entire lever link for signs of cracking around or near welds, and for any bending resulting from binding.
- 3. Repair any lever links showing signs of binding or bending in the lever link.

#### Maintenance

- Remove as much corrosion and/or flyash deposits as possible from around the lever link pivot point.
- Lubricate pivot pins inside the lever link hubs with penetrating oil as best as possible.
- Pack area around lever link pivot points with Molykote, or any other white grease, to prevent any corrosion or flyash deposits from accumulating directly on the pins or entering the hubs at these points.
- 4. Reinspect the lever links annually, remove any corrosion or flyash deposits and repack with grease. (continued on reverse side)



### Warning

The lever link is a load carrying component, and should not be removed from the hanger assembly without first relieving the load.
